

Conference request for webinars

Rationale: our conference platform is open two days prior to conference. We aim to bring research to our members.

What we request from research students: A webinar which has practical implication for either assessment or teaching which can inform members of up-to-date research.

The researcher must be studying at level seven or above and have completed a research project which has been a research project that has been independently marked and qualification has been awarded.

What the research should present:

- (a) Abstract regarding the research
- (b) A webinar between 15 to 20 minutes regarding the research
- (c) Content:
 - 1. Title
 - 2. Author
 - 3. Awarding qualification where the research has been published
 - 4. Author contact email address for delegates to email the researcher for any follow questions
 - 5. Why did the researcher choose this area of research -the gap in the area of knowledge or the intellectual puzzle that the researcher wished to address.
 - 6. Very brief explanation of methodology
 - 7. Findings
 - 8. Conclusion possible implications for practitioners either in teaching or assessment practice.
 - 9. Any further evidence or research needed – (a request for further data from members if needed)
 - 10. For possible publication in the PATOSS Bulletin please see the separate details.
 - 11. For the conference booklet a 300 to 600 article is needed by the 3rd of February 2023. This would be alongside your PowerPoints presented by the researcher.

No payment will be made to the researcher and the research would appear following the conference on the PATOSS website. We can record the webinar if the researcher requests for us to record it. If the researcher wishes to attend the conference, they will pay the conference fee as a delegate.
